Understanding Compliance Standards

Key Compliance Considerations

- **State-Specific Laws:** Regulations vary by state and may change every 3–6 months.
- **Patient-Provider Relationship:** Store-and-forward technology is required to establish care. Avoid reliance on simple questionnaires.
- **HIPAA & Data Security:** Use encrypted, HIPAA-compliant platforms.
- **Documentation Best Practices:** All asynchronous interactions must be time-stamped and integrated into the EHR.
