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IMLC Screener/Eligibility Flowchart

Introduction

The following flowchart serves as a guide to determine eligibility for IMLC (Interstate Medical Licensure Compact). This streamlined process ensures that applicants meet the necessary criteria before proceeding with their applications.

Step 1: Initial Qualification Check

- Do you hold a full, unrestricted medical license in a Compact Member State?
 - Yes → Proceed to Step 2.
 - No → You are not eligible for IMLC.

Step 2: Educational & Certification Requirements

- Have you graduated from an accredited medical school (LCME, COCA, or an equivalent recognized by ECFMG)?
 - Yes → Proceed to Step 3.
 - No → You are not eligible for IMLC.
- Have you successfully completed an ACGME- or AOA-accredited graduate medical education program?
 - Yes → Proceed to Step 3.
 - No → You are not eligible for IMLC.
- Are you board-certified by an ABMS or AOA member board?
 - Yes → Proceed to Step 3.
 - No → You are not eligible for IMLC.

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Step 3: Background & Disciplinary Review

- Have you ever had a controlled substance license or permit suspended or revoked?
 - Yes → You are not eligible for IMLC.
 - No → Proceed to next question.
- Have you ever been convicted, received probation, or deferred adjudication for any offense?
 - Yes → You are not eligible for IMLC.
 - No → Proceed to next question.
- Have you ever been disciplined by any medical board?
 - Yes → You are not eligible for IMLC.
 - No → Proceed to Step 4.

Step 4: Final Approval & Application Process

- If you meet all the above criteria, you can proceed with your application through the IMLC website.
- Submit necessary documents and fees as required.
- Undergo background checks and verification by your State of Principal Licensure (SPL).
- Upon approval, receive your Letter of Qualification and proceed with licensing in participating states.
