## All In Remote Physician Academy Telemedicine Informed Consent **Checklist**

Patient Identification
Confirm patient's identity at the beginning of the session.
Nature of Telemedicine
Explain telemedicine's limitations compared to in-person care.
Risks and Benefits
Describe potential risks (e.g., technical issues, privacy concerns).
Outline benefits (e.g., convenience, accessibility).
Privacy and Confidentiality
Explain how patient data will be protected (e.g., HIPAA compliance).
Technical Requirements
Inform about necessary technology (e.g., internet, device requirements).
Address possible technical issues (e.g., connectivity problems).
Alternative Care Options
Provide information about alternatives if telemedicine isn't suitable (e.g., inperson care).
Consent to Record
Obtain consent for video/audio recording (if applicable).
Jurisdictional Considerations
Confirm that the provider is licensed in the patient's state/country.
Right to Withdraw Consent
Inform patient they can withdraw consent and request in-person care at any time.
