

Telemedicine Informed Consent Checklist

Patient Identification

- ☐ Confirm patient's identity at the beginning of the session.

Nature of Telemedicine

- ☐ Explain telemedicine's limitations compared to in-person care.

Risks and Benefits

- ☐ Describe potential risks (e.g., technical issues, privacy concerns).
- ☐ Outline benefits (e.g., convenience, accessibility).

Privacy and Confidentiality

- ☐ Explain how patient data will be protected (e.g., HIPAA compliance).

Technical Requirements

- ☐ Inform about necessary technology (e.g., internet, device requirements).
- ☐ Address possible technical issues (e.g., connectivity problems).

Alternative Care Options

- ☐ Provide information about alternatives if telemedicine isn't suitable (e.g., in-person care).

Consent to Record

- ☐ Obtain consent for video/audio recording (if applicable).

Jurisdictional Considerations

- ☐ Confirm that the provider is licensed in the patient's state/country.

Right to Withdraw Consent

- ☐ Inform patient they can withdraw consent and request in-person care at any time.
